This year on **Wednesday, December 21** the two youth casts of *A Christmas Carol* will share their smiles and beautiful voices at another incredible organization: **Rehabilitation Institute of Kansas City (RIKC).** The **Rehabilitation Institute of Kansas City** is an outpatient rehabilitation center that contracts with Children's Mercy Hospital to provide rehabilitation services for children and adolescents who have had strokes, have cerebral palsy, spinal cord injuries, brain injuries, etc. It's an amazing place with wonderful people who provide these kids with intensive rehabilitation services - Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, school

reintegration, as well as Neuropsychology support. Across the street, they also work with **Children's TLC** who provide therapeutic and educational services for children with disabilities. The caroling will take place from 4pm – 5pm through the halls of the **Rehabilitation Institute of Kansas City**.
